- DIY Puzzle Toys : Get creative with household items to make homemade puzzle toys. For example, you can place treats inside a muffin tin, cover each compartment with tennis balls, and let your dog figure out how to uncover the goodies. Another idea is to stuff a cardboard toilet paper roll with treats, fold the ends, and let your dog roll it around to release the treats. - Interactive Training Sessions : Turn training into a fun game for both you and your pup. Teach them new tricks or
